- Over 12 months of meticulous planning for the 6-window storyboard.
- 50 animated actions, bringing each scene to life with dynamic interactions.
- A diverse wildlife collection featuring 30 distinct animal figures, including leaping lemurs, grazing giraffes, and playful tiger cubs.
- Detailed lifelike figures of Terri, Robert, and Bindi Irwin, crafted with incredible authenticity.
- A poetic narration by Ace, a wedge-tailed eagle, incorporating the voices of Robert and Bindi Irwin.
- Custom-built animatronics designed to mimic the natural movements of the animals, enhancing visitor engagement.
- Scenic elements and props meticulously created to reflect the beauty of Australia Zoo's environment.

The Christmas Windows will also be celebrated with an activation on Level 6 in Mural Hall, Myer Melbourne, featuring *Christmas at the Crocoseum* a commissioned production from Terrapin Theatre Company based on the Australia Zoo Wilidlife Warrior Show.
